President's Message

Another year riding the WAVE of God's love and promises for His young people has gone by. Without a doubt He continues to lead us toward the many opportunities to ride with Him!

This year was a year of rest for WAVE Hawai'i. In July of 2008, I was diagnosed with cancer of the spinal column. Tiny tumors with one large tumor settled at the base of my spine. I developed an infection during the biopsy and was in a coma for a week. After two weeks I was released from the hospital with a pic line sticking out of my arm and six weeks of intensive antibiotics being pumped to my heart. I was on high doses of pain medication and eventually had to undergo five weeks of radiation. I spent 2009 in physical and massage therapy. Today I am stable.

I say all of this because I know, beyond a shadow of a doubt, time is short. Many are doing what they can to assure every young person they come in touch with has a place in God's kingdom.

Although this year was a year of rest for WAVE, our partnerships remained alive and well. In July, Christian Endeavor Hawai'i held their second annual IGNITE event, Ready for Battle, at the Bay View Restaurant and Golf Club in Kaneohe. Two days of music, message, food, and fun! Christian young people from the windward side of O'ahu came together to encourage one another as they prepared for the school year.

To end 2009, WAVE prepared for the first ever Praise and Worship family event focused on Christian young people at the historic Hawai'i Theatre. It was held in January 2010! This time of praise was so successful we plan to do it at the Hawai'i Theatre again some time later this year!

In God's plan for 2010, we continue to focus and strengthen our partnerships with Christian Endeavor Hawaii and the third annual IGNITE Summer Youth Conference. We also look forward to a partnership with 'Ohia Productions and the launch of a WAVE Hawai'i Performing Arts Academy. This partnership would give Christian young people, with gifts in music, dance, and drama, and all aspects of production, an opportunity to share their gifts in a theatre venue.

On behalf of the WAVE Hawai'i Board of Directors, I want to say thank you for your prayers and contributions to this ministry. We look forward to God's "infinite, beyond our wildest imaginations" plan for us this coming year!
